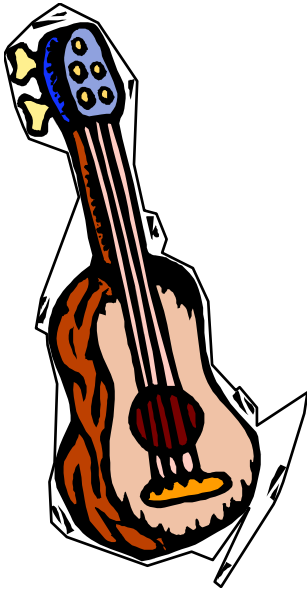


Sailing, Sailing

So we could stay afloat!

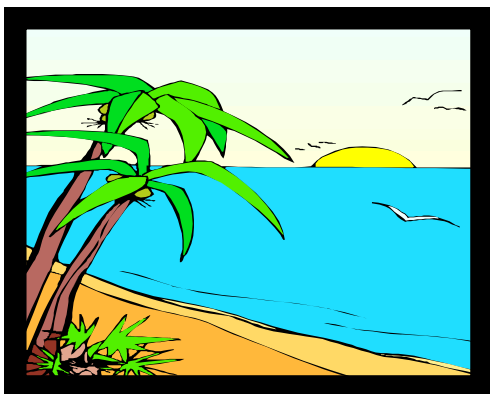
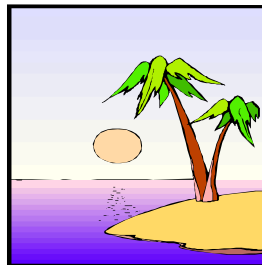


Sailing, Sailing,
